2010 Membership Information

Student - \$575

A student of The Ohio State University carrying 12 or more (undergraduate) or 10 or more (graduate) credit hours for the ENTIRE Spring Quarter may purchase a student membership. Memberships are valid until March 31st of the following year. This enables a student to play as many times as he/she wishes without paying a green fee. It also permits the student to make advanced tee times and bring up to three guests. A spouse and/or children may be added; the spouse could be added at the Alumni rate. Annual dues for children under 13 of a Member are \$288. Annual dues for children 13-23 of a Member are \$824.

Faculty/Staff - \$800 Initiation Fee / \$1,916 Annual Fee

Any full time or retired Faculty/Staff Member of The Ohio State University is eligible to acquire an annual golf membership by payment of the applicable Faculty/Staff Membership fee. Proof of employment or retirement status is required upon applying for Membership. Full time Faculty/Staff is defined as 50% or more FTE. Retired Faculty is defined with emeritus designation or 25 years of service. Retired Staff is defined as 25 years or more of service at The Ohio State University (not including buy-out). This Membership enables an employee of the University to play as many times as he/she wishes without paying a green fee. It also permits an employee to make advanced tee times and bring up to three guests. A spouse and/or children may be added; the spouse could be added at the Alumni rate. Annual dues for children under 13 of Member are \$288. Annual dues for children 13-23 of a Member are \$824. A \$120 food and beverage minimum applies. A tournament fee of \$40 also applies.

Alumni - \$1000 Initiation Fee / \$2,395 Annual Fee

Any current member of The Ohio State University Alumni Association is eligible to purchase an annual golf Membership by payment of the applicable alumni membership fee. A valid alumni membership card must be provided at the time of application. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION DO NOT QUALIFY TO BE PRIME MEMBERS OF THE CLUB. Associate members must join under their spouse who would be the prime member. Once a member, you may play as much as possible while paying no green fees. Members may also make advanced tee times and bring up to three guests. A spouse and/or children may be added; the spouse could be added at the Alumni rate. Annual dues for children under 13 of Member are \$288. Annual dues for children 13-23 of a Member are \$824. A \$120 food and beverage minimum applies. A \$40 tournament fee also applies.

Buckeye Club Members - \$1,000 Initiation Fee / \$4,895 Annual Fee (Includes Buckeye Club Membership)

Current members of the Buckeye Club at the Big Ten Champions, National Champions and Scholar-Athlete Levels are eligible to obtain an annual golf membership. A valid member number must be approved at the time of application. For further details about joining the Buckeye Club and/or becoming a Member of The Ohio State Golf club, please call the Golf Shop or Buckeye Club office at (614) 292-9908. A spouse and/or children may be added; Annual dues for children under 13 of Member are \$288. Annual dues for children 13-23 of a Member are \$824. A \$120 food and beverage minimum applies. A \$40 tournament fee also applies.



2010 \$40 OSU Tournament Fee Summary

Tournament Fee Summary: The OSU Tournament fee was initiated to increase member participation during scheduled member tournaments. Furthermore, the Club felt like we needed to bridge the gap of the now defunct “Scarlet & Gray Club”. The fee is mandatory for all OSU members, excluding students and juniors.

What does the fee include? The \$40 Tournament Fee includes:

- 1 Complimentary Guest Round on Gray good thru 2010. A current member roster will be maintained by the golf shop staff at the time of use;
- Entry fees (with the exception of Member-Guest events) for each event;
- Entry fee/prizes for the Wednesday night putting contests prior to Wednesday night 9 hole event;
- Drink tickets and a pre/post tournament cook-out for each event. The two day member events will include complimentary dinner after the first round;
- All events include range balls during the day of play;
- All events (with the exception of gender specific member-guest events) will be “mixed” events, handicapped and flighted accordingly;
- Prizes (paid in golf shop gift certificates) for each event;
- 100% of the total collected will be spent on the annual tournaments;

Tournament Fee Value:

- The value of the complimentary Gray guest pass is \$40;
- The value of each one-day event is approximately \$17. The approximate value of a two-day event is \$40;

Our goal is to increase member participation, promote member camaraderie while at the same time minimize the closure of either golf course for less than “full-field” events as we have had in the past.

Referral Program Goals:

1. Promote OSU annual membership to qualified OSU Alumni, Faculty and Staff.
2. Increase OSU annual membership base;
3. Give incentives to current OSU Alumni, Faculty and Staff for successful NEW OSU Members.

Referral Program Outline:

1. Referring member would receive a statement credit (incentive) on the following months' billing upon full payment of dues and fees of new or former qualifying member;
2. Spouses/Children of active members do not qualify for referral program;
3. Not applicable for student referrals; not applicable for student members;
4. Incentives based on current membership year;
5. Incentive is non-transferable;
6. Member must include referring member with completed application;
7. NEW member definition –
 - a. Qualifies to be a Prime Member at OSU Golf Club;
 - b. Has never held a membership at OSU Golf Club;
 - c. Has not been an active OSU member in the previous 12 months;
 - d. Qualifies as a member *of the Buckeye Club or President's Club;*

Members may book 5 days in advance. Daily fee players may book 1 day in advance for weekdays and the day of play for weekends and holidays. To book online, a Member will need to enter their 4 digit Member Number and follow the steps.

1. Members of The Ohio State University Golf Club may book online beginning at 6:00a.m. 5 days in advance. For example: Members may book a starting time for Saturday beginning 6:00a.m. the Monday before.
2. Members of The Ohio State Golf Club may book by phone beginning at 7:30a.m. 5 days in advance.

Guest Policy

Golf Club Members may bring up to 3 guests at anytime on either course with the exception of only 1 being permitted on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays before noon on Scarlet.

Starter Greeting (Members should expect to hear this greeting before every round of golf.)

Welcome to The Ohio State Golf Club (Scarlet Course or Gray course). To make the day enjoyable for everyone, please be advised that the expected pace of play is (4 hours and 12 minutes for Scarlet and 3 hours and 52 minutes for Gray). To help monitor the Pace of Play, we have added Pace of Play Clocks at different points around the course. These clocks should reflect your **starting time** (not the current time of day). Please respect the course by replacing divots or filling them in with sand, rank bunkers, and repair all ball marks. All riding and pull carts should be kept in the fairway and at least 30' from bunkers and greens at all times. Please keep carts on paths when possible. For your convenience, player assistance carts will be on the course to assist any groups that may need guidance throughout the day. We hope you enjoy your day on the (Scarlet or Gray course).

DRESS CODE

The Ohio State Golf Club, in an effort to maintain the integrity of the game of golf, has adopted the following dress codes for men and women. All players are required to wear proper golf attire at all times. Proper attire includes, but is not limited to, collared or mock neck shirts (no t-shirts or tank tops), mid length shorts (no athletic shorts), golf slacks (no denim or jogging suit).
